



REVISED RULES OF ORIGIN (ROO) AND OPERATIONAL CERTIFICATION PROCEDURES (OCP) ENTER INTO FORCE 6 AUGUST 2019

Origin Criteria

Wholly Obtainer or Produced Good

Plants, animals, seafood harvested and grown in Singapore.



Waste and scraps from local manufacturing or used goods fit only for recycling

Manufactured Products

Regional Value Content



At least **40%** of its content must originate from Asean-China region

Change in Tariff Classification (CTH)

A **4-digit** change in HS code for non-originating materials
**CTH for select Chapters except for those listed in Product Specific Rules*

De-minimis Rule

Value of non-originating materials that did not undergo the required Change of Tariff Classification:



1. Should not exceed **10%** of the FOB value of the good.

OR

2. Should not exceed **10%** of the total weight of the good.

(Does not apply to Chapter 50-63 of the Harmonised System)

Changes to Origin Criteria Declaration in Form E

A new set of origin criteria is adopted for Box 8 of Form E:

Origin Criterion in Old Requirements	Origin Criterion in New Requirements	Remarks
WO	WO	Good is wholly produced or obtained in the country of origin.
	PE	Good produced in a Party exclusively from originating materials from one or more of the Parties.
SCC / ACC	RVC	Good satisfying the "Regional Value" Content origin criterion
	CTH	Good produced from non-originating materials in a Party, satisfying the "Change in Tariff Classification at 4-Digit level.
PSR	PSR	Good satisfying the PSR in Attachment B of Annex 1 ROO



The transmission of the electronic Preferential Certificate of Origin (PCO) / electronic Certificate of Non-Manipulation (CNM) to China came into effect 1 November 2019
